
Decision-Making Skills

Decision-Making Skills: HPV Vaccine Example

- 1. Identify decision: Get the vaccine or not?
- 2. Options:
 - Get vaccinated now
 - Wait until later
 - Don't get vaccinated
- 3. Identify Possible Outcomes
 - No
- > 90% likelihood of being exposed to HPV
- Although not all HPV types cause cancer, some do
- HPV also causes genital warts
- If become infected, risk exposing future partner(s) to virus
- Wait
 - If vaccine started before 15 years, need 2 shots; if started later need 3 shots
 - If infected with HPV before vaccinated, vaccine no longer helpful to prevent disease

- Yes
- Lifetime protection against cancers caused by HPV (men and women)
- Protect against passing on HPV to others
- Minor, temporary discomfort at the site of injection
