**Seiji Yamada, MD**

Dr. Seiji Yamada is a faculty member in the University of Hawai'i Dept of Family Medicine & Community Health, a part-time family physician at the Primary Care Clinic of Hawaii, and medical director of the Lāna'i Community Health Center.



**Michael Haight, MD, MHA**

Dr. Michael Haight is currently the Medical Director at AlohaCare and continues patient care as a Clinical Professor at the University of California San Francisco. He has broad experience in clinical operations, patient safety, population health, coaching, telehealth, clinical research, and health systems science.



**Vivian Huang, MD, MPH**

Dr. Vivian Huang is currently the regional medical director for Dynavax, working in 13 states to reduce the incidence of HBV through vaccination. She has an extensive public health background as a staff member in NYC working in COVID-19 contact tracing and global HIV/TB/ HBV/ Ebola/ Leprosy prevention and treatment programs.

Hawai'i has high rates of liver cancer, and one of the leading causes is vaccine-preventable hepatitis B. To address this, we are collaborating with local and national partners to host a free series of community talk story sessions on hepatitis B vaccine updates.
