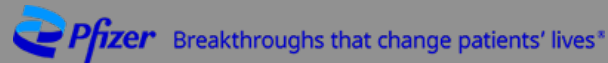

### **COL(R) Dr. Patrick M. Garman, BS, PharmD, MBA, MS, PhD**

Dr. Garman currently serves as a Medical Director in Pfizer's Vaccines Medical Development & Scientific/Clinical Affairs. In this role he interacts with, and provides vaccine related medical, scientific, and research consultation to both national and local healthcare systems and their healthcare providers.

He retired from the United States Army in 2020 at the rank of Colonel. During a portion of his 29-year military career Dr. Garman directed the Department of Defense's Military Vaccine Agency where he led the development, synchronization, and implementation of DoD immunization research, safety surveillance, and policy.

Dr. Garman has served on National Academies of Science Committee work groups and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices work groups, as well as the CDC's Federal Vaccine Steering Committees and the Department of Health and Human Service's National Vaccine Program Office's Federal Immunization Safety Task Force.

He is a native of Ohio and currently resides with his family in Fountain Hills, Arizona. He attended Ohio Northern University where he received his Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy. He earned a Master's in Business Administration from the University of Maryland; a Doctor of Pharmacy degree from The Ohio State University; a Doctor of Philosophy degree - specializing in Pharmaco-epidemiology, from the University of Florida; and a Master of Science in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College.
